



# Getting around

The Fruit Loop Drive is approximately a 10km round trip. You can do the trail in half a day, depending on how long you spend in each location and how many delicious tastes you can eat in one day!

Carnarvon is located 900km north of Perth. You can fly to Carnarvon with Regional Express (Rex) from Perth Airport. Flights depart daily and are approximately 2.5 hours. You can travel by bus with Integrity Coachlines from Perth Bus Depot. The bus departs three days per week and the trip is approximately 12 hours. Driving from Perth to Carnarvon is appoximately 10 hours and it is recommended to break your trip up stopping in Geraldton or Kalbarri.

The local and friendly Carnarvon Visitor Centre team can assist with booking accommodation, tours and events in Carnarvon and surrounds. The Visitor Centre should be your first stop on your journey. The centre provides a wide range of local products available for purchase and tastings of our local delicacies.
