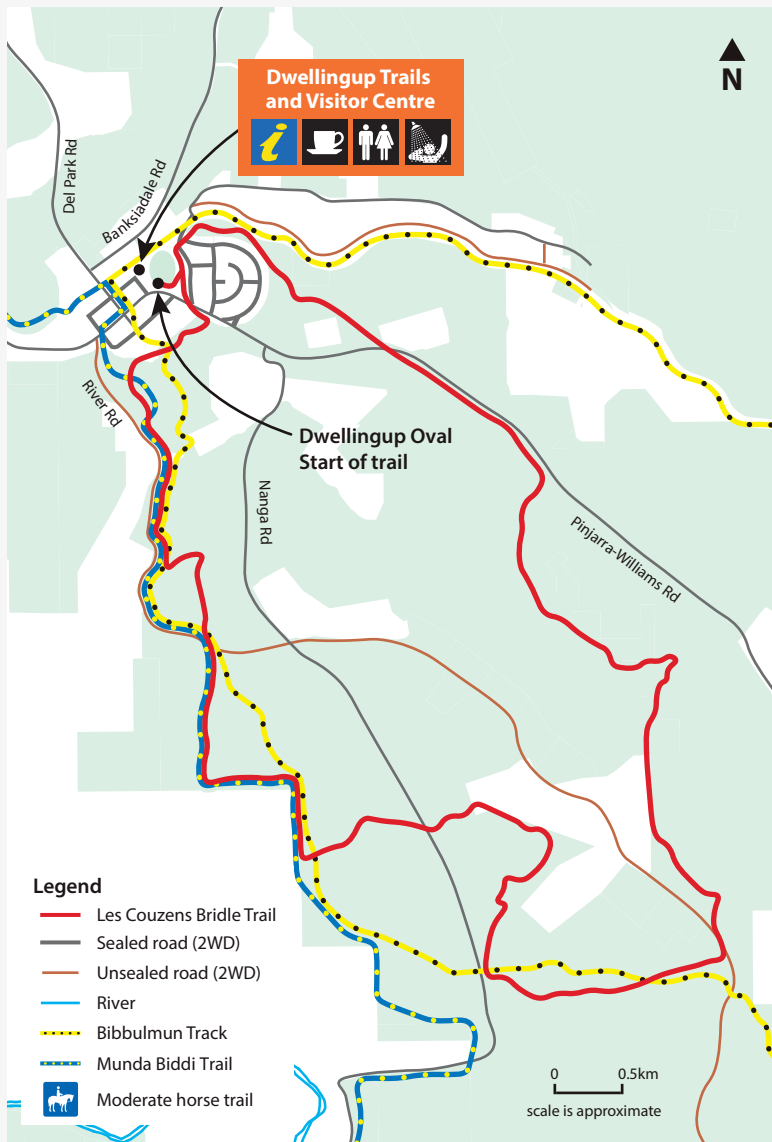


Les Couzens Bridle Trail

Les Couzens Bridle Trail

Moderate 17km loop. Allow 3 to 4 hours

Trail varies in terrain with some steep sections and can be rocky, so shod or booted horses are recommended.

The Les Couzens Bridle Trail offers riders a serene and peaceful horseback experience. Embarking from the heart of Dwellingup, this horse riding trail forms a loop that takes you through picturesque jarrah and marri forest and pine plantations, showcasing the enchanting landscapes of the Peel Region.

Please be aware of vehicles and mountain bikes as the trail shares sections of the Munda Biddi Trail and roads, which it crosses at multiple points. Float parking is located at the gravel carpark next to the playground at Dwellingup Oval, near Dwellingup Trails and Visitor Centre.

Ride safely, tread lightly

- Be sure that you have read the trail information before you set out.
- Always carry adequate water and supplies. Remember to drink regularly.
- Wear appropriate riding gear, sun protection, and carry suitable clothing for changing weather.
- Travel with a buddy and ensure a trusted contact knows your itinerary and what to do if you are overdue.
- Do not rely on your mobile phone as coverage is limited. Check with your service provider prior to departure.
- Keep to the marked trail to protect wildlife habitat and prevent the spread of Phytophthora dieback disease.
- Be courteous to other trail users.
- Loose or slippery rocks and uneven track surfaces may be encountered.
- Please take all rubbish including food scraps out with you and dispose of in the bins provided.
