- Walk amongst the treetops on the Lotterywest Federation Walkway (open 9 am – 5 pm daily).
- See Gija Jumulu, our 750-year-old Boab tree.
- Take a free guided walk with a Kings Park Guide at 10 am, 12 noon and 2 pm daily.
- Follow the Boodja Gnarning Aboriginal Walk Trail.
- Shop at Aspects of Kings Park, Gallery Shop.
- Take the family to May Drive Parkland, the Lotterywest Family Area or Rio Tinto Naturescape Kings Park.
- Enjoy an outdoor concert, film or play in the summer events season.
- Visit the Kings Park Festival held each September.



## Getting here

Kings Park and Botanic Garden is:

- 10 mins from Perth city by bus
- Open 24 hours, every day
- Free (no admission charge).

Free public transport between Kings Park & the city centre:

- Transperth Bus No. 935.
- Red CAT Bus to West Perth, about a 1 km walk to Kings Park from the closest drop-off point.
- Green CAT Bus operates Monday to Friday, stops just outside the park on Kings Park Road.

Enjoy glorious views of the Swan River and Mt Eliza escarpment. Explore the unique flora of Roe Gardens and Kings Park Bushland. Moderate degree of difficulty. Enclosed footwear, sunscreen, hat and water needed.



## BUSHLAND AND WILDFLOWERS

August – October 1½ hrs

Discover spring wildflowers along the Nature Trail where you may encounter encounter 'milkmaids and postmen, pixies and fairies, donkeys and spiders'. Paths suitable for wheelchairs.



## HEART OF KINGS PARK

July – October up to 3 hrs

Tread hidden paths and discover how plants survive in this challenging environment. Moderate degree of difficulty, some dirt tracks, up to 5 km. Enclosed footwear, sunscreen, hat and water needed.
